GUBERNATORIAL PROCLAMATION

Whereas, alarming trends in our national personal financial marketplace include: American consumer credit exceeding \$2 trillion; the current level of personal savings as a percentage of personal income at one of the lowest levels in history, two percent; through November 2004, over 1.8 million individuals filing for bankruptcy; as well as increasing instances of identity theft; and

Whereas, the financial well being of individual Rhode Island citizens is linked to our State's and Nation's economic health; and

Whereas, personal financial literacy is linked to individual financial well being; and

Whereas, personal financial literacy education involves active engagement on the part of individual citizens and family units in an ongoing and evolving process; and

Whereas, governments, private businesses, community-based organizations and institutions of education are stakeholders in the pursuit of increased personal financial literacy, and by working together, can help individual consumers make informed decisions about their finances; and

Whereas, the personal financial education of all citizens, especially youth and other vulnerable populations, will improve the quality of their lives, will provide them with skills for success, and contribute to positive changes for the communities in which they live and work; and

Whereas, public and private partnerships such as the Rhode Island JumpStart Coalition for Personal Financial Literacy, seek to improve the personal financial literacy of Rhode Islanders, by promoting educational initiatives throughout our State;

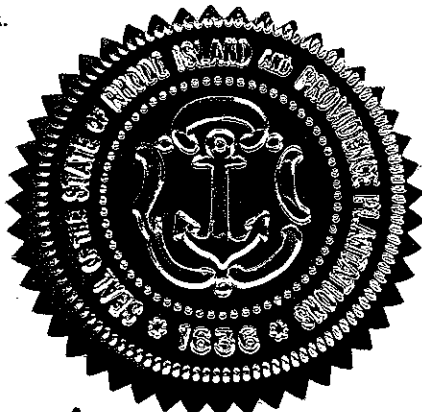
